Position Overview: Communities In Schools of Chatham County is seeking a passionate and organized Youth F.I.R.S.T. Mentoring Program Assistant to join our team. This position plays a pivotal role in supporting youth through mentorship, lunch and reading buddies programming, and case management under the Youth F.I.R.S.T. initiative.

Reports To: Youth F.I.R.S.T. Mentoring Program Coordinator and Program Director

Key Responsibilities:

- Engage in community outreach activities, including speaking engagements and presentations at events like street fairs, school events, and local businesses.
- Assist the Program Coordinator in recruiting and matching volunteers to support students across Chatham County.
- Maintain active involvement with agencies and initiatives benefiting matched youth, mentors.
- Expand community partnerships to provide youth with mentors, resources, and activities (e.g., faith-based organizations, nonprofits, businesses, universities).
- Obtain incentives for volunteers and youth to support program engagement.
- Collaborate with Chatham County Schools to enhance mentoring and lunch/reading buddies' programs.
- Support the mentorship of 65 youth annually through one-on-one relationships or case management at partnered schools (Pittsboro Elementary, George Moses Horton Middle School).
- Monitor mentor matches through regular check-ins, providing supervision and support throughout each match's duration utilizing CIS data management system.
- Assist in developing Individual Service Plans for students in collaboration with mentors and parents.
- Maintain comprehensive files documenting contact with volunteers, parents/guardians, and other stakeholders, ensuring compliance with screening and privacy regulations.
- Help recruit, train, and screen prospective volunteers, implementing activities to encourage mentor retention and appreciation.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in social work, education, or related field OR 3-4 years of relevant experience
- Experience in youth services, mentoring, or educational settings.
- Strong organizational and communication skills. Spanish fluency preferred.
- Ability to build effective partnerships and engage with diverse stakeholders.
- Familiarity with data management and program evaluation.
- Commitment to CIS mission and values, including educational equity and youth empowerment.

Hours and Salary: This position will be full time (40) hours per week with benefits. Pay for the position is \$19.50/hr.
